Planned Activities Implemented

1. In the provision of HIV Testing and Counselling services, 249 general population were tested for HIV, 7 were positive 382 pregnant women were testing for HIV for which 1 was positive, this gives total positive cases detected for the second quarter to be 8 cases and 21 cases for first half of the year
2. All positive cases have been linked into care. Already existing cases had their sample taken for viral load testing and medications supplied.
